- ✓ Breakfast on your own.
- ✓ Depart hotel lobby ~8:00 a.m., take PATH Blue/Yellow line to Manhattan (PATH fare is \$2.50 per trip).
- ✓ Walk to the southern end of The Highline.
- ✓ Experience and photograph the Highline from Gansevoort St. north to 30<sup>th</sup> St.
- ✓ Meander south towards Greenwich Village: Street Photography and Lunch.
- ✓ Visit an Hispanic Catholic Church: "Our Lady of Guadalupe at \$t. Bernard's Church".
- ✓ Visit and shoot Washington Square.
- ✓ Visit the **Leica Photography Gallery**, 670 Broadway (one of only eight Leica Galleries world-wide).
- ✓ Go to the 9<sup>th</sup> Street PATH Station and take the PATH Blue/Yellow line back to Newport and the Courtyard Hotel.
- ✓ Dinner on your own at time of your choosing.

#### Some after dinner options for your consideration:

- ✓ Option 1: Take PATH Green line to **World Trade Center & 9-11 Memorial**.
- ✓ Option 2: Take PATH Blue/Yellow line to 33<sup>rd</sup> St. station & walk to **Times \$quare**, for night photography.
- ✓ Option 3: Shoot **southern Manhattan skyline** from Liberty State Park.
- ✓ Option 4: Take PATH to Manhattan; then take NYC Subway to Brooklyn to photograph the east side of Manhattan, the Brooklyn Bridge, and the Manhattan Bridge.

- ✓ Return to Manhattan via PATH Blue/Yellow line to visit: **B&H Photo-Video** (9<sup>th</sup> Ave. between 33<sup>rd</sup> and 34<sup>Th</sup> Streets), **Adorama Camera** (42 W. 18<sup>th</sup> St.), **International Center of Photography** (1133 Ave. of the Americas @ 43<sup>rd</sup> St.), **Muşeum of Modern Art** (11 West 53<sup>rd</sup> St.), **Metropolitan Muşeum of Art** (1000 Fifth Ave.), or any other site you may desire.
- ✓ Drive ~3 miles to Liberty State Park and take ferry to Elli\$ I\$land and/or the \$tatue of Liberty.






#### Location of Courtyard Jersey City Newport, NJ relative to Manhattan sites:






#### Saturday night – Option 1, Take PATH Green line to World Trade Center and the 9-11 Memorial:






#### Saturday night – Option 3, Drive to Liberty State Park and shoot southern Manhattan Skyline:




